Admissions in MBBS/BDS courses (2017-18) IN Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Hospital and Mahatma Gandhi Dental College & Hospital

Admissions on NRI Quota seats and State Quota seats in MBBS & BDS courses for the academic year 2017-18 respectively in Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Hospital and Mahatma Gandhi Dental College & Hospital – units of Mahatma Gandhi University of Medical Sciences & Technology, Jaipur shall be made on merit basis from amongst NEET UG – 2017 qualified candidates by the UG Admission Board NEET – 2017 constituted by the Government of Rajasthan.

Candidates desirous to seek admission in MBBS & BDS courses respectively in Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Hospital and Mahatma Gandhi Dental College & Hospital are advised to get themselves registered with the UG Admission Board NEET – 2017. **In case a candidate does not get himself/herself registered with the UG Admission Board NEET – 2017, he/she will not be eligible for admission to MBBS/BDS course in any medical/dental college in Rajasthan.** Even for admissions on the residual vacant seats during/after the mop-up round of seat allotment by the State Government UG Admission Board, it would be necessary for the candidates to get themselves registered with the UG Admission Board NEET – 2017.

All eligible candidates who wish to participate in the counseling process MUST GET THEMSELVES ON-LINE REGISTERED through these websites. It is mandatory step for subsequent process of allotments. A candidate who does not register will not be eligible for allotment in any round (Round 1 online and round 2 off line).

Registration shall be ON-LINE and from July 15, 2017 to July 20, 2017 up to 5:00 P.M.

Eligibility –

Eligibility for admission to MBBS/BDS course shall be as laid down in the Notification/Instructions issued by the UG Admission Board NEET – 2017.

- i) For NRI Quota seats any Foreign Nationals/PIO/NRI/ children or wards of NRI can apply for admission.

According to admission regulatory committee of Govt. of Rajasthan (as per direction of hon'ble Supreme Court of India) in NRI quota description of 'ward' word "an NRI who undertakes to sponsor a student for admission as guardian need not be a blood relation". Hence the 'ward' in case of NRI admission means a candidate whose guardian is a bonafide NRI. 'Ward' does not mean related by the blood.

For NRI Quota seats, Domicile Certificate is not required.

- ii) For State Quota seats, a candidate should fulfill the domicile conditions of the State of Rajasthan.

In addition, candidates will be required to deposit tuition fee for minimum next two years period of the course duration at the time of admission in the form of cash security / Bank guarantee from a Nationalized Bank. Other than NRI students (State Quota seats) – Rs. 2,75,000/- (Rupees Two Lac Seventy Five Thousand) per annum at the time of admission. In addition, candidates will be required to deposit tuition fee for minimum next two years period of the course duration at the time of admission in the form of cash security / Bank guarantee from a Nationalized Bank.
