### **ADMISSIONS ON RESIDUAL VACANT SEATS OF MD/MS COURSES (2018-19) IN MAHATMA GANDHI MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, JAIPUR**

The Supreme Court of India in WP (c) No.(s) 556/2018 U.P. Unaided Medical Colleges Welfare Association (Regd) Versus Union of India & Ors has ordered on 25.5.2018 that the vacant seats of MD/MS courses for the year 2018-19 in unaided private medical colleges may be filled, from amongst the eligible NEET PG – 2018 qualified candidates who have not taken admission in PG MD/MS course anywhere, through the counseling to be done by the Chairman, NEET PG Medical & Dental Admission / Counseling Board-2018 and Principal & Controller, SMS Medical College & Attached Hospitals, Jaipur latest by May 31, 2018. Copy of the Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard is placed at the end of this notification.

Accordingly, the eligible candidates, desirous to seek admission on the residual vacant seats of MD/MS courses in Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Hospital, Jaipur are advised to get themselves registered with the Rajasthan State NEET PG Medical & Dental Admission/ Counseling Board-2018. As per the Supreme Court Orders, a candidate who has already secured admission shall not be permitted to resign from the concerned college to avail of the opportunity of admission now.

## STIPEND –

Students admitted in the MD/MS courses in Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Hospital will be paid stipend during their training period at par with the Government Medical Colleges in Rajasthan.

## ELIGIBILITY –

1. Candidate must have qualified NEET-PG 2018 conducted by National Board of Examinations, New Delhi for admission to MD/MS courses.
2. Candidate must be registered with the Rajasthan State NEET PG Medical & Dental Admission/Counseling Board–2018.
3. The candidate must have completed satisfactorily one year's compulsory rotatory residential internship (CRRI) on or before 31.03.2018.
4. Candidate should have Registration with the Medical Council of India or any of the State Medical Council or should obtain the same within one month from the date of his admission, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled.

## SEAT ALLOTMENT

Seat allotment shall be done by the Chairman, NEET PG Medical & Dental Admission / Counseling Board-2018 and Principal & Controller, SMS Medical College & Attached Hospitals, Jaipur as per the notification issued by him in this regard. The candidates are advised to visit [www.education.rajasthan.gov.in/](http://www.education.rajasthan.gov.in/) / [medicaleducation, www.rajprepg2018.in](http://medicaleducation, www.rajprepg2018.in) regularly for the notification, seat allotment schedule etc.

9. Marks sheet of the II MBBS examination.
10. Marks sheet of the III MBBS (Part – I) examination.
11. Marks sheet of the III MBBS (Part – II) examination.
12. MBBS Attempt Certificate.
13. Internship Completion Certificate.
14. MBBS Degree/Provisional Certificate issued by the University.
15. Permanent registration certificate from Medical Council of India or Rajasthan Medical Council or other State Medical Council.
16. Character Certificate from the Institution attended last.

UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R



We have heard Mr. Abdhesh Chaudhary, learned counsel  
for the petitioner, Mr. Ankur Prakash, learned counsel

for the State of Uttar Pradesh and Mr. Gaurav Sharma, learned counsel for the Medical Council of India.

During the course of argument, learned counsel for the Medical Council of India suggested that in view of the peculiar situation of almost 41.95% of post-graduate medical seats in the private unaided medical colleges in the State of Uttar Pradesh have remained vacant for the academic year 2018-2019 and as the cut-off date is already over on 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2018, in the larger public interest, Dr. K.K. Gupta, Director General of Medical Education (Respondent No.4) must take the responsibility of allotting students from the All-India NEET Merit List in order of merit to the respective colleges by 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2018.

We find this suggestion to be most appropriate and also assuage the grievance of the private medical colleges and open up new opportunity to the aspiring candidates in the merit list who otherwise could not secure admission in other medical colleges.

We accept the aforementioned suggestion and direct the Respondent No.4 to take immediate steps in this behalf, in right earnest, while ensuring that the cut-off date of 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2018 is adhered to in its letter and spirit. Be it noted, no request for extension of time for any reason whatsoever will be entertained hereafter.

We make it clear that in the guise of recommending names of candidates to private colleges, the candidate who has already secured admission elsewhere cannot be permitted to resign from the concerned college to avail of the opportunity under the stated dispensation.

We appreciate the suggestion given by Ms. Pinky Anand, learned Additional Solicitor General that similar dispensation can be followed in other States, if they so desire while ensuring that the cut-off date of 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2018 is strictly adhered to.

We agree with this suggestion.

Learned Additional Solicitor General as well as Mr. Gaurav Sharma assure the Court that this decision will be forthwith published on the official websites of the Medical Council of India, Medical Counselling Committee and the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

The petition stands disposed of.
