

Minutes of Thirty Seventh Meeting of Board of Management (MGUMST) (March 15, 2023)

Thirty Seventh meeting of the Board of Management (BOM) of the Mahatma Gandhi University of Medical Sciences & Technology, Jaipur was held on Wednesday, March 15, 2023 at 2:00 P.M. in the Board Room, R.K. Academic and University Block of the University.

The list of participants who graced the occasion is appended as **Appendix-1**. Out of total 13 members, 10 members including the Chairman participated in the meeting.

Dr Hari Gautam and Dr Girdhar J. Gyani participated in the meeting through Video Conferencing. Dr B.S. Sharma being at Jabalpur for Oration, Professor I. K. Bhat being engaged in NAAC accreditation at Faridabad and Shri Sunil Sharma, IAS, Commissioner, College Education being busy in pre-scheduled program could not attend the meeting.

Dr Swati Garg, Dean & Principal, MGMC&H, Dr Narendra Padiyar, Dean & Principal, MGDC&H and Shri R.N. Kogata, Financial Advisor attended the meeting as special invitees.

The Chairman accorded a cordial welcome to all the members of Board of Management and appreciated their contribution towards growth of the University.

The Chairman informed that Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Hospital has been awarded with NABH Nursing Excellence Certificate by Quality Council of India, New Delhi. MGMC&H is the first in the State of Rajasthan and Ninth in India to receive this prestigious NABH Nursing Excellence Certificate.

He further informed that Dr M.L. Swarankar, Emeritus Chairperson of the MGUMST, as special alumnus of SMS Medical College & Hospital has been honoured with Excellency Award by the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the Medical & Health Minister of Rajasthan for the contribution made by Dr Swarankar in the field of medical and health not only in Rajasthan but in India as well. Dr Sudhir Sachdev, President and other faculty members of the University have also been awarded with Special Alumni Award at this Platinum Jubilee Celebration on March 04 & 05, 2023.

The Chairman also informed that the Mahatma Gandhi Nursing College has been awarded as "Best Nursing College for Academic Excellence" by Institute of Education and Research, New Delhi in 4th International Nursing Conference on 7th October 2022 and further that Dr Subhash Nepalia, PHOD, Department



of Gastroenterology, MGMCH has been nominated as Member, Rajasthan Medical Council by the Government of Rajasthan.

It was also informed that the University invited Padma Shri Dr Harsh Mahajan, Founder & Chief Radiologist, Mahajan Imaging, New Delhi for "Ist Dr K.D. Gupta Memorial Oration" and also Dr Sanjeev Gupta Professor of Medicine (Hepatology) and Pathology, The Eleazar and Feige Reicher Chair in Translational Medicine, Albert Einstein College of Medicine, New York for University Guest Lecture on October 12, 2022.

The members congratulated the Chairperson and his entire team for the achievements as stated above. They also congratulated Dr M.L. Swarankar and Dr Sudhir Sachdev for being honoured at Platinum Jubilee Celebration of SMS Medical College and Hospital Alumni.

(SC-88)/DO dated 7th December, 2022 received from the NAAC. This has also been reported to the Academic Council at its meeting held on December 30, 2022.

He also reported that alumni of Mahatma Gandhi Nursing College have made substantial contribution including LED 42 inches TV, Water Cooler 80 L, 11 Wall Clocks, Portable Mic & Speaker and Interactive Education Display 75 inches.

The Board noted the progress made by the IQAC. The Board resolved that the decisions already taken in its meeting held on 22.09.2022 be executed expeditiously: -

- i) Each department of the Medical College must conduct at least five projects every year. The Principal & Controller, MGMC&H must ensure it and submit progress report to the Pro-President (Chairman, Board of Research) regularly.
- ii) Upgradations of all institutions of the University should be taken up rather than focusing only on the Medical College & Hospital. Respective Principals/Director constituent teaching units, in consultation with the Maintenance and Accounts & Finance Departments, must submit their proposals in this regard to the President.

- iii) Principals of all the colleges of the University must arrange alumni meets of respective colleges regularly and submit its calendar to the University for information and record.
 - The Principals must encourage the alumni for more contributions to the respective college/ university for the benefit of students.
- iv) Each criteria coordinator of the seven criteria of the NAAC must prepare plan for the activities related to his/her criteria and submit the calendar of the activities to the Director/Coordinator of the IQAC.
- v) The progress of research work & publications be reviewed quarterly by a committee consisting of Dr Nikhil Marwah, all the Principals and the Pro-(Chairman President of Committee) and it must be ensured that each faculty member publishes at least two research papers in a year.

The Board desired that the University must strive to get A++ grade from the NAAC by the time the Institute celebrates Silver Jubilee of its establishment.

8. Items with the permission of the Chair -

i) Purchase of land

It was reported by the Chief Finance & Accounts Officer that the University has purchased a land (ISI 9, RIICO Institutional Area) of the



area 21220.54 square meters from RIICO through e-auction on November 21, 2022. The land is on 99 years lease. Total cost of the land is Rs. 1014258864.00. The Board approved the purchase of the land and congratulated the University Authorities for the said purchase of the land.

ii) Participation of the MGUMST in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)

With the permission of the Chair, Dr Bushra Fiza, Professor, Department of Biochemistry, MGMC&H, who has been given the responsibility of making all preparations for participation of the MGUMST in India Rankings – 2023, gave a power point presentation in the meeting of the Board. She explained that the NIRF outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. There are several parameters for determining rankings of the Universities and Institutions across the Country. The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception".

She apprised the Board about the progress made so far towards participation of the MGUMST in NIRF – 2023. The Board noted the progress and expressed that many areas require improvement so as to get good ranking. It was proposed that the data presented by the Institutions having good rankings in NIRF – 2022 like AIIMS, New Delhi and Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal should be gone through by Dr Bushra Fiza along with the Director/Coordinator, IQAC to learn more for making good preparations by the MGUMST to participate in NIRF Rankings – 2023. Use of Visitors' books and formats be brought in practice for having feedback from External Examiners, Assessors, Visitors, Bankers and the Faculty Members of other Universities coming to the MGUMST for attending Conferences/Workshops/Seminars.

iii) Recognition/Permission of the courses

It was expressed that there is a need to ensure that all the courses being conducted by the University must have proper permissions/recognitions from the respective Statutory Regulating Bodies. Necessary steps should be taken by the University wherever necessary approvals are still required.

iv) Academic Audit

It was informed to the Hon'ble members of the Board that despite having good faculty members and state-of-the-art infrastructure, recently started



MD courses like (i) Immuno-haematology and Blood Transfusion and (ii) Laboratory Medicine could not attract any candidate and (iii) Hospital Administration could attract only one candidate for admission in 2022-23. Likewise, DM courses – (i) Cardiac Anaesthesia, (ii) Critical Care Medicine, (iii) Neuro – Anaesthesia and (iv) Hepatology could not attract any candidate and (v) DM Neurology and (vi) MCh Neuro Surgery could attract very few candidates for admission in comparison to the intake capacity.

Apart from the above there are many MD/MS/MCh courses which despite having no tuition fees could not attract any candidate for admission.

The above stated position of admissions in the said MD/MS and DM/MCh courses reveals that there is a need of academic audit in the University. In order to improvise the admissions in broad and super specialty courses the President along with the Dean & Principal, MGMC&H should have meetings with the Heads of the concerned departments and find out ways and means to make more admissions in these courses in future. Similarly, in other courses of the University meetings should be conducted with the concerned Principals for more admissions, good teaching and examination results in the respective courses.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
