Green Campus Policy

- Use of solar PV generation shall continue and faculty members and students to identify and explore other methods of green energy usage.
- The institute shall facilitate participatory documentation of its flora and fauna with the help of experts, environmentalists and the student community for whom it would be an educational and sensitization process.
- The green committee shall look in to the various environmental aspects for green technology and green environment. The Performance of waste water treatment, waste recycling, rain water harvesting and other water conservation measures shall also be monitored.
- The objective of the green committee shall be reduce carbon and water footprint, enhance water quality and biodiversity in the campus, and time to time update the green policy.
- The institute shall develop a baseline data on water use, waste generation and disposal, carbon footprints, paper use etc.
