Restricted entry of Automobiles

As a part of Green Practices University encourages the use of bicycles and public transport. Students and staff have been facilitated to use the bicycle in the premises. MGU is situated near the NH-8. To ease the conveyance facility for the commuters, bus stop was established in front of the main gate of the institution. Owing to this, most of the day scholars and faculty members use public transport for daily commute. Other commuters use shared transport. Jaipur City Transport Services Ltd (JCTSL) also provides city bus services (Bus No 19,95) from Jaipur to MGU campus

Battery powered vehicles

An electric cart is also available to move around in the campus. Electric cart is available to help patients, senior citizens and any one unable to move walking.

Pedestrian friendly pathways

The roads inside the campus, as well the approach roads, are provided with wide sidewalks. Further, tree lines are planted along these sidewalks, thereby providing shades. At every crossing, clear road marks have been painted and wherever required, marked speed breakers have been provided for safe pedestrian crossing. Student volunteers and security personnel regulate the traffic during rush hours

Ban on the use of Plastics

As an eco-friendly campus, the university restricts the usage of non-biodegradable products and the major step towards its preservation is banning the use of plastic in any form on the campus.

We encourage the use of Paper cups Paper and jute bags prepared out of recycled material.

GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVE (Ban on single use plastic)

Most of our plastic ends up in land-fills, oceans and water ways and the environment. Plastics do not biodegrade. Instead they slowly breakdown in the smaller pieces which contaminate our soil and water. Efforts to reduce our dependence on single use plastics is the only solution. Ban on the use of non-recycled plastic bottles, plastic straws, carry bags, food wrapping plastic films is the need of the hour.

Keeping in view the above and Green Campus Initiative, all the faculty members, staff, PG residents, students and all the persons residing in the campus should restrict the use of "Single Use Plastics" in side the campus. All the vendors, shop keepers and canteen in-charges in the campus must immediately stop the use of single use plastics in the University premises.

Strict ban on single use plastics - water bottles, carry bags, food packings etc. has to be ensured by all concerned. If any noncompliance is seen in this regard and anyone found selling, bringing or possessing any of "Single Use Plastic" article/material in the University premises, it will be considered as violation of these instructions and appropriate action will be taken against the agency and/or the person concerned.


V. GREEN AREA

Project is located in the vicinity of many trees (species) to maintain the bio-diversity. Approx 1969 nos. of trees are in project which includes various species.






Figures 12: Photographs showing green area
