Pattern of the Written Entrance Examination –

1. There will be one question paper of two hours duration.
2. The question paper shall contain total 100 MCQs on General Knowledge, Analysis & Reasoning, English Comprehension and Basic Sciences.
3. The medium of Entrance Examination shall be English.
4. Candidates will be required to attempt all the questions.

Schedule of Personal Interview –

Candidates who appear at written entrance examination will be required to appear before the Admission Board for Personal Interview for interaction and assessment as under:-

Date of Personal Interview : Monday, June 24, 2019 Time: 03:00 P.M. onwards

Venue : University Conference Hall

Candidates shall be required to report at 2:30 PM in the Vivekanand Hall of the University for Personal Interview.

The Admission Board shall also verify all the original documents of the candidate necessary to determine his/her eligibility for admission to Certificate/Graduate Courses.

Candidates shall be required to produce their original documents (including permission/no-objection certificate from the employer, in case of in service candidates) at the time of Personal Interview.

Such candidates who do not produce on Monday, June 24, 2019, the proof of passing their qualifying examination as mentioned in the eligibility criteria shall not be considered for admission.

Result –

Merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates combined in the written entrance examination and the personal interview.

Final merit list of the candidates will be uploaded on the University website.

- Last date of receipt of Application Form – Friday, June 14, 2019 up to 5:00 P.M.
- Date of Entrance Examination & Personal Interview – Monday, June 24, 2019
- Last date of deposition of tuition fees – Friday, 05 July 2019.
- Commencement of the academic session – Monday, 15 July 2019

- 1) Following relevant Original documents and one set of photocopy are to be brought by the candidate at the time of Personal Interview otherwise the candidate shall not be considered for personal interview.
 - Marks sheet of the Secondary School Examination (10th Class) showing date of birth.
 - Marks sheet of qualifying examination, as applicable (as mentioned in the "eligibility" column of this Notification).
 - Caste Certificate, if applicable, along with Domicile Certificate.
OBC/MBC Non Creamy layer Certificate shall be valid only if its issue date is within twelve months prior to the notified last date of submission of the Admission Application Form.
- 2) Following relevant Original documents and one set of photocopy are to be brought by the candidate before deposition of tuition fees otherwise the candidate shall not be considered for admission.
 - Transfer Certificate from the Institute last attended.
 - Character Certificate from the Institute last attended.
 - Migration Certificate from the concerned University (in case the University is other than the MGUMST).
 - No objection certificate/permission from the present employer for allowing the applicant for the applied full time regular course at the MGUMST (in case of in-service applicants).
 - Other relevant certificate(s) asked by the Admission Board, if any
- 3) Incomplete application forms or the forms received after the last date on account of postal delay or any other reason shall not be accepted.
- 4) Reservation policy will be applicable as per Rajasthan Government directives.
- 5) Once a candidate has taken admission after depositing admission fees (tuition fees/post dated cheque) but does not join the course or leaves the course any time after the admission, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled and the admission fees deposited will not be refunded.
