Note:

- 1. Admit card shall be emailed to the registered email I.D. of candidate 3 days before the entrance examination. Candidate shall download his/her admit card from his/her email I.D. and take a print before reaching the examination centre.
- 2. Candidate shall report on the e-mail: admissions@mgumst.org about non-receipt of admit card up to one day before entrance examination.
- 3. Candidate shall bring with him/her admit card and original valid photo ID in the Examination Hall.
- 4. After declaration of the result of the written entrance examination, the candidates who qualify for the counseling must ensure their eligibility (as mentioned in Admission Notification) on the day of counseling.
- 5. Such candidates, who do not bring the original documents in proof of their fulfilling the eligibility, shall not be allowed for counseling. They shall not be considered for admission and the candidate next in merit shall be called.

Pattern of the question paper and marking

M. Phil. Clinical Psychology

- 1. The Entrance Examination question paper shall contain Multiple Choice Type Questions (MCQs) related to Psychology. The medium of written entrance examination shall be English.
- 2. The question paper shall contain 100 MCQs.
- 3. The result of the candidates who appear at the written entrance examination shall be uploaded on the University website. The candidates who qualify written entrance examination and are higher in merit shall be required to attend the counseling as per the category wise available seats.
- 4. No separate intimation regarding result of the entrance examination shall be given to individual candidate.

M.Sc. (Med.), MPT, MOT, BPT, BOT, M. Sc and B. Sc

- 1. The Entrance Examination question paper shall contain Multiple Choice Type Questions (MCQs). The question paper shall contain 50 MCQs. The medium of written entrance examination shall be English.
- 2. The result of the candidates who appear at the written entrance examination shall be uploaded on the University website. The candidates shall be required to attend the counseling for admission.
- 3. No separate intimation regarding result of the entrance examination shall be given to individual candidate.

Note:

Following relevant <u>Original Documents</u> and one set of self attested photocopy of the documents are to be brought by the candidate at the time of counseling otherwise the candidate shall not be considered for counseling:-



- Marks sheet/Certificate of the Secondary Examination (10th Class) showing date of birth.
- Marks sheet of 10+2 (Senior Secondary) or its equivalent Examination.
- Marks sheet of qualifying examination, as applicable (as mentioned in the "eligibility" column of the admission notification, uploaded on the University website on June 21, 2023).
- Transfer Certificate from the Institute last attended.
- Character Certificate from the Head of the Institute last attended.
- Valid Certificate (as on date of counseling) for Reservation Category (EWS/SC/ST/OBC-NCL/MBC-NCL etc.) if category is other than General Category.
- Internship completion certificate, if applicable.
- Domicile Certificate & Aadhar Card.
- Disability Certificate, if applicable.
- No objection certification/permission from the present employer for the applied regular full-time program (for in service candidate only).
- Migration Certificate from the concerned Board/University (in case the University is other than the MGUMST) can be deposited within two months from the date of admission.
- Other relevant certificate(s), if any.

Last date for depositing fees

Last date for depositing tuition fees, caution money, enrolment fees, post-dated cheques (as applicable), as already notified in the admission notification dated June 21, 2023 for the candidates who are given provisional admission letters by the Admission Board is Thursday, August 10, 2023.

Commencement of the course from Wednesday, August 16, 2023.

The candidates are being permitted to appear at the written entrance exam solely on the basis of information provided by them in their admission application form. They must ensure meeting the eligibility criteria mentioned in the admission notice against the course for which admission is sought. At any stage a candidate found in-eligible even after qualifying the entrance examination, his/her admission may be cancelled and fees deposited shall be forfeited.
