Bachelor of Occupational Therapy (B.O.T.)

Bachelor of Occupational Therapy (B.O.T.) is an undergraduate course program for the candidates who wills to be a part of rehabilitation team and work as a health care professional for the betterment of an individual's physical and mental well-being.

Occupational Therapy is the art and science of directing man's participation in selected tasks to restore, reinforce and enhance performance. It facilitates learning of those skills and functions essential for adaptation and productivity and to promote and maintain health.

Occupational Therapy uses particular activities as an aid for betterment from physical or mental illness. An occupational therapist is defined as a person who "assists people across the lifespan in engaging in the activities they want and need to do through the therapeutic use of everyday activities (occupations).

This program is formulated to enable the student to gain adequate knowledge, skills and clinical hands-on experience leading to establish them as an independent professional in clinical practice.

- These services are provided for clients who have or are at risk for developing an illness, injury, disease, disorder, condition, impairment, disability, activity limitation, or participation restriction.
