Entrance Test for admission to Ph.D. Programs (2024-25)

It is notified to all the candidates who have applied for admission to Ph.D. programs 2024-25 in response to this office earlier notification dated June 17 and July 24, 2024 that the schedule of the Written Entrance Test shall be as under:

Schedule of Written Entrance Test:

Date : 09.08.2024 (Friday)

Time : 11:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M.

Venue : Vivekanand Hall, (Ground Floor) Mahatma Gandhi Medical College

Admit cards have been emailed to the candidates on their registered email ID. Candidates may download their admit cards from their email ID and take a print before reaching the examination centre on August 09, 2024.

Candidates who have not received their admit cards must immediately report on the e-mail: admissions@mgumst.org about non-receipt of admit card.

Candidates shall bring with them, their admit card and original valid photo ID in the Examination Hall.

Pattern of the Written Entrance Test:

- 1. There will be one question paper of one-hour duration.
- 2. The question paper booklet shall contain 50 MCQs of 2 marks each. There will be two parts in the question paper. Part-A shall consist of 25 MCQs on Research Methodology and Part-B shall be of 25 MCQs on subject specific.
- 3. The medium of Entrance Test shall be English.
- 4. Candidates will be required to attempt all the questions.

Instructions to Examinees:

- 1. Candidates will write answers of the MCQs in the OMR answer sheet.
- 2. Answers if given by the candidate in the question paper booklet will not be evaluated.
- 3. Candidates are strictly forbidden to bring with them any material like mobile phones, calculators, Bluetooth or any electronic device, book or written paper in the Examination Hall. Possession of any such material will be treated as unfair means and the candidate will be disqualified for the Written Entrance Test.

Result of written entrance test:

Result of the Written Entrance Test shall be declared and uploaded on the University website. Hence, the candidates are advised to see their results on the University website. No separate intimation regarding result of the entrance test shall be given to individual candidate.



1. Faculties other than the Faculty of Nursing

Candidates who secure atleast 50 % marks in the Written Entrance Test shall be called for the interview/viva-voce for admission to Ph.D. course. A relaxation of 5% marks will be allowed to qualify the entrance test to the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/MBC/differently-abled category, Economically Weaker Section (EWS), and other categories as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

2. Faculty of Nursing

Candidates who secure 60% marks i.e. 54 out of maximum 90 marks in the Written Entrance Test shall be called for the interview/viva-voce for admission to Ph.D. course.

Important:

Candidates are advised to ensure their eligibility for admission as per the notification issued on June 17, 2024. The candidates found in-eligible at the time of counseling or afterwards at any stage, will lose their candidature for admission.

Schedule of Interview & Viva-voce Examination:

Candidates who qualify the written entrance test shall be required to appear before the Admission Committee for Interview & Viva-voce for interaction and research aptitude assessment as under:

Time	:	11.00 A.M.
Venue	:	R.K. Academic & University Block, MGUMST Campus

The Admission Committee shall verify all the original documents of the candidate necessary to determine his eligibility for admission to Ph.D. program.

Criteria for selection:

1. Faculties other than the Faculty of Nursing

A weightage of 70% for the written entrance test and 30% for the performance in the Interview/Viva-Voce shall be given.

2. Faculty of Nursing

Marks obtained out of maximum 100 marks will be converted so as to make them out of maximum 90 marks. Selection shall be based on

(i) Entrance test marks obtained out of 90 marks

(ii) 5 marks for candidates possessing M.Phil. in Nursing

(iii)5 marks weightage for publications

The Admission Committee shall take into account-performance of the candidate both in written test and interview/viva-voce for his/her selection to Ph.D. program.



Candidates who are selected for Ph.D. program shall be required to produce their original documents (including permission/no-objection certificate from the employer, in case of in-service candidates) at the time of interview/viva-voce by the Admission Committee on 13.08.2024. Candidates found suitable for admission in all respect shall be issued provisional admission letter.

Fees Deposition:

Candidates selected by the Admission Committee for admission to Ph.D. program shall be required to deposit Ph.D. program fee as under:

Candidates selected by the Admission Committee for provisional admission to Ph.D. program shall be required to deposit fee latest by Friday, August 30. 2024.
